How to Clean Acadia

100% HYPHYN™ Biodegradable Vinyl

Hyphyn™ Vinyl biodegrades over 90% within 24 months in landfill conditions, per ASTM D5511 testing. Its patented enzyme system activates only in anaerobic landfill environments, breaking down the material into inert components like CO₂, methane, and biomass without producing microplastics or harmful residues. Post-biodegradation soil tests confirm zero detectable chemicals of concern, with 100% plant germination in resulting soil, ensuring environmental safety.

This pattern also features the finish Resilience™ which represents the latest in technology in Faux Leather and Vinyl Protection, enhancing performance where it is needed the most.

Prompt cleaning is always recommended.

Recommended cleaning steps are listed by type of stain. For best results follow cleaning steps in order.

Recommended Care and Cleaning Guide:

STEP 1: Regular Cleaning and Maintenance (Dirt · Dust · Grime)

Clean the soiled area with mild soap and water, then rinse with fresh water and wipe dry with a clean cloth.

STEP 2: Food Stains / Oils (Ketchup · Chocolate · Coffee / Tea · Salad Dressing · Butter · Soy Sauce)

Wipe affected area with a soft cloth with appropriate pressure. If some stains persist, clean with mild soap and water. Rinse with fresh water and wipe dry. For stubborn stains, spot clean with a 70% dilution of isopropyl alcohol (rubbing alcohol) and water and wipe. Rinse with fresh water and wipe dry.

STEP 3: Healthcare / Disinfection (Blood • Urine • Iodine • Betadine)


Clean the soiled area with a 10% solution of household bleach and water. It is important to rinse the cleaned area with fresh water after applying the bleach solution.

STEP 4: Difficult Stains (Eye Shadow / Mascara · Lipstick · Crayon · Grease · Mustard · Motor Oil)

Clean the soiled area with 70% solution of isopropyl alcohol and water. It is important to rinse the cleaned area with fresh water after applying the alcohol solution.

NOTE: The use of commercial vinyl conditioners and protectants is NOT RECOMMENDED.
