

How to Clean Equator

PVC Free Polyurethane

Prompt cleaning is always recommended. Ordinary dirt and stains can be removed with mild soap and water. For more persistent stains use undiluted Isopropyl Alcohol or a 3:1 Bleach solution.

Equator will resist without serious discoloration, the repeated actions of normal dilutions of non-abrasive chlorine or ammonia-based cleaners.

NOTE: Be sure to rinse the cleaned area with clean water and dry with a lint free cloth.

NOTE: The use of commercial vinyl conditioners and protectants is NOT RECOMMENDED.
