

Intrepid Detailed Cleaning Instructions

How to Clean Intrepid

High Performance Vinyl with MGX MorGuard Xtreme™

Recommended Care and Cleaning Guide:

For Normal Cleaning:

In general, most common stains can be cleaned using warm, soapy water and clear water rinses. Moderate scrubbing with a medium bristle brush will help loosen soiling materials from the depressions of embossed surfaces. For more stubborn stains, use Formula 409® commercially available cleaner[†] in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.

If Normal Cleaning Does Not Work:

Full strength rubbing alcohol or mineral spirits^{††} may be tried cautiously as a last resort on very stubborn stains if the above suggestions do not work. Indiscriminate use of any solvent or solvent containing cleaner can severely damage or discolor vinyl. Always follow with a clear water rinse after cleaning with solvents. Ink Cleanable: tough stains can be cleaned with isopropyl alcohol. Quick attention to spills and stains increases the likelihood of removal.

Disinfecting Guide

Bleach:

Dilute with water up to a 9:1 (9 parts water to 1 part bleach) ratio (10%). Liberally apply diluted disinfectant using a sponge. Rinse with cold water several times. Wipe dry and repeat if necessary. Federal regulations require that guidelines on the bleach label need to be followed for antiseptic or antimicrobial purposes.

- · Sporicidal Hard Surface Disinfectant
- Oxivir Plus Disinfectant (1:40 ratio)
- Healthlink EZ-KILL Wipes
- Metrex Cavicide
- Virox 5 (1:16 ratio)
- Virex 256
- Oxivir TB
