

How to Clean Nimbus

Performance Fabric with a Soil and Stain Repellent Finish

Recommended Care and Cleaning Guide:

Regular and proper maintenance of fabric permits less frequent cleaning. Maintenance is routine on-going care, which reduces soil build-up on a fabric's surface. Vacuum and clean fabrics regularly to remove accumulated grime and air-borne dust and lint. This will help to retain the fabric's original appearance as much as possible.

Promptly treat spots and stains using the proper cleaning process for the fabric. When cleaning a spill, blot immediately to remove as much of the problem area as possible. Clean all existing and remaining spots and stains from the inside to the outside of the stain to help prevent "circling".

For routine spot / stain cleaning:

WS - Spot clean with a mild detergent upholstery shampoo, foam from a mild detergent, or dry cleaning solvents. Pretest a small inconspicuous area before proceeding. Do not saturate area being cleaning. Blot/dry/remove all cleaning solution once finished with cleaning.

NOTE: Do not use any concentrated household, ammonia/chlorine or bleach based cleaners.
