Genuine Leather Care Considerations:

- Protect leather from direct sunlight, extreme heat and sharp objects.
 - Always remove contaminants as quickly as possible in order to avoid residue on the leather product.
 - Regularly wipe the leather with a damp cloth.
 - Wipe leather in a circular fashion with a cloth moistened with a very mild Soap solution.
 - Dry and polish the leather with a dry cloth.
 - Avoid soaking the leather.
 - Avoid chemical cleaning agents with solvating agents such as alcohol or benzene.
 - Generally test all cleaning agents in an inconspicuous location.

Recommended cleaning steps are listed by type of stain. For best results follow cleaning steps in order.

Recommended Care and Cleaning Guide:

STEP 1:

Most common everyday soiling and spills can be easily removed using a mixture of 10% household soap and 90% warm water. Apply the mixture with a clean, soft and dampened cloth. Rub gently, then rinse with a clean, soft and dampened cloth with water and let dry.

STEP 2:

For more stubborn stains or for heavy soiling, use a soft clean cloth with a 50/50 solution of Formula 409® or Fantastik® and water. Gently rub the affected area with a soft clean cloth and rinse with water.

STEP 3:

For the most difficult of stains, use a soft, clean and damp cloth with a mixture of 10% household bleach and 90% water. Rub the affected area gently and rinse with a clean, soft, and dampened cloth with water to remove bleach concentrate.

NOTE: The use of certain cleaning agents, including but not limited to powdered abrasives, solvents, industrial strength cleaners, and power washing is not recommended and can be harmful to the surface appearance and the lifespan of the product.
