

How to Clean Theory

Performance Fabric with a Soil and Stain Repellent Finish

Recommended Care and Cleaning Guide:

Frequent vacuuming or light brushing with a non-metallic, stiff bristle brush is recommended to remove dust and grime and prevent overall soiling.

As with any spill, immediate cleaning care is advised. Blot the stain with a soft cloth to remove excess material. Spot clean the affected area with upholstery shampoo, foam from a mild detergent, or a mild dry cleaning solvent. Pretest a small, inconspicuous area before proceeding. Do not saturate the stain. Take care to clean spots or stains from the outside to the middle of the affected area to prevent circling on the fabric.

Use a professional furniture cleaning service if an overall soiled condition has been reached. Hot water extraction or steam cleaning is not a recommended cleaning method.

NOTE: Do not use any concentrated household, ammonia/chlorine or bleach based cleaners.
