

Class I : Cover fabric shall meet the criteria of (A) and (B)

(A) When subjected to the cover fabric test, a specimen shall show no evidence of ignition of any test assembly

(B) The vertical char in any of the three specimens shall not exceed 45 mm

Class II : Cover fabric that do not meet Class I criteria shall be designated as Class II
